The IQAC Committee Meetings were held in the office of the Principal under the Chairmanship of the Principal on 06.08.2016 and 12.12.2017. The members of the committee discussed and resolved various academic and administrative issues in the meetings. The IQAC prepared the Plan of Action for the Academic Year 2016-17 and the college administration made its implementation as follows.
