All the infrastructural facilities are optimally uslized by the students, teachers and non-teaching staff of the college. The decisions regarding construction, repair and maintenance of the buildings and other physical facilities are taken by the committees-Building Committee and College Development Committee. Mainentance of laboratory instruments, computers, printers, LCT TV, projectors, water, power supply and Laptops is done by hiring technicians. For purchasing new equipments decisions are taken by the Purchase Committee following due procedure. Expenditure is done from yearly allotted budget approved by the CDC.
